Applications submitted via email should also include a scanned signature for Parts VII and VIII of the application form. Letters of recommendation should be sent separately via email by the recommenders. Letters of recommendation must be submitted on university or company letterhead and contain the signature of the recommender.

The fellowship application is separate from the candidate's application for admission to the Graduate School of Education, the Harvard Kennedy School, or the Harvard T.H. Chan School of Public Health. Applications for admission must be submitted to the appropriate school according to the deadline established at that school.
